# Aran – Pig / Giraffe Hoof Print Pocket Scarf – Baby to Adult Sizes



## **Materials and Measurements**

The quantities of yarn stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate

#### **Tension**

 $4 \frac{1}{2}$  mm 20 sts x 26 rows = 10cms (4ins) using st-st.

It is essential to obtain the correct tension with the yarn used, a small test square should be worked. If the test square measures more than the required measurements, try again using smaller needles. If the test square measures less than required measurements, try again using larger needles.

#### **Abbreviations**

Rib = K2, P2, St st = Stocking stitch (1 row knit, 1 row purl), rep = repeat,

#### **Needles**

Pair 4 ½ mm (UK7-USA7) needles and 5 ½ mm (UK5-USA9)

#### **Technique**

Each colour is worked with a separate ball of yarn, and the yarns are crossed at the colour change to lock the sections together.

#### To change colours in the middle of a row:

- 1. With the first colour, knit up to the colour change, drop the first colour.
- 2. Pick up the second colour, crossing the yarn underneath the first colour, and work the first stitch tightly.
- 3. Give the end of the old colour a slight tug to lock the colours together, continue knitting with the second colour.

#### **Hoof Print Pocket**

Using 4 ½ mm (UK7-USA7) needles and main cast on 19(25, 29)sts

Work paw print chart for the required size.

#### Chart note

Each square is one stitch. Knit rows are worked right to left and are odd numbered rows. Purl rows are worked left to right and are even numbered rows.



Next row: K3, \*P2, K2\* repeat from \* to \* to last 0(2, 2) sts, 0(P2,P2) sts

Next row: K0(K2, K2) sts \*P2, K2 rib to end in pattern as set.

Repeat the last 2 rows 1(2, 3) times more. Cast off loosely in rib.

Using 5 ½ mm needles cast on 22(28, 32)sts. Next row: K3, \*P2,K2\* to last 3 sts, P2, K1

Repeat the last row till scarf is 90(120, 152)cm, or the required length. Cast off loosely in rib.

#### To finish



With the inside facing sew a pocket to both ends of the scarf. Turn the pockets the right way.


## **Optional**

Make 4 pom poms and sew to each corner of the scarf.


1<sup>st</sup> size – 10cm X 90cm



2<sup>nd</sup> size – 13cm x 120cm



3<sup>rd</sup> size – 15cm x 152cm



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
